

Reasons Why Your Application May Not Have Been Successful

We have listed a number of reasons below which may explain why applications do not progress beyond the Expression of Interest stage. We hope that this will be helpful.

1. The project does not meet our age range specifications.
2. The project is not solely for young women and girls.
3. Round 2 only. Your project works more widely than with young women already in contact with the criminal justice system.
4. Your proposed project does not work exclusively or primarily with young women and girls in the areas we have listed.
5. The work described is not linked closely enough to Criminal Justice System associated outcomes.
6. The work described shows insufficient evidence of gender and trauma informed expertise.
7. The organisation does not appear to be expert in the areas listed as per the definition provided in our published criteria.
8. The work described shows insufficient evidence that this project has been designed with lived experience at its core.
9. The information on your website does not appear to align with the descriptions in your application.
10. The organisation's annual income falls outside our minimum and maximum annual income thresholds.
11. The applicant has not waited 12 months or more from the previous submission date to reapply.
12. The applicant has previously applied for funding for exactly the same project.
13. The applicant is based outside the UK.
